3. Enclose an official copy of your most recent high school grade transcript.
4. Enclose a copy of your SAT or ACT scores.
5. Briefly explain why you would be a good recipient of a PPL Montana Family Scholarship.
6. Enclose two letters of recommendation from non-relatives who can attest to your academic and personal achievements and abilities. Each letter should include the person's name, occupation (if appropriate) and relationship to you.

A: One letter must be from a teacher or a high school counselor.

B: One letter must be a personal reference from a non-relative who is NOT a teacher or a counselor.
